

ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarships offered by Scotch College provide substantial remission of fees, allowing able students of many different backgrounds to attend the School, regardless of the financial circumstances of their parents. The scholarship program not only benefits individual students and their families, but further enhances the intellectual and social diversity of the student community, resulting in a more stimulating educational experience for all boys.

Scholarships are available for entry to Scotch College's **day school** or **boarding school** in Year 7, Year 9 and Year 10 in 2013. Scholarships for academic excellence are offered in the subject areas of English and Mathematics. Music scholarships are available for boys with outstanding musical ability and means-tested scholarships are awarded to boys whose parents would not otherwise be able to send their sons to the School.

Dates

Applications open on: Thursday 1 December 2011.

Closing date for applications: Tuesday 14 February 2012 at 5.00pm. Early applications are encouraged; late applications are not accepted.

Scholarship examination: Saturday 25 February 2012, 8.45am – 12.00pm

Music auditions: Sunday 26 February 2012 or earlier by arrangement with the Director of Music.

❖ Year 7 Entrance Scholarships – for the day school or boarding

Eligibility

The scholarship examinations are open to boys who are not yet attending the Scotch College Senior School.

- ❖ **Year 7 Entrance Scholarships** are offered to all boys who are in Year 6 in 2012, including students attending the Scotch College Junior School.

- ❖ **Year 9 and Year 10 Entrance Scholarships** are offered to boys who are in Year 8 and Year 9 in 2012. Students currently attending the Scotch College Senior School are ineligible.

A boy may compete only once for a Year 7 Scholarship, once for a Year 9 Scholarship and once for a Year 10 Scholarship. No boy may be the holder of more than one College competitive scholarship. Scholarships are awarded at the Principal's discretion and a scholarship may be withdrawn if the Principal is not satisfied with the diligence or conduct of the holder.

How to enter

Applications open on Thursday 1 December 2011. A completed entry form and entry fee of \$35.00 for each candidate must reach the Director of Admissions no later than 5.00pm on **Tuesday 14 February 2012**. Early applications are encouraged. The fee covers a boy's entry for all scholarships. Applications can be made by mail or online using the College's website www.scotch.vic.edu.au

Details of the examinations

Scotch College conducts its own scholarship testing program, which involves tests in both English and Mathematics. No further information about the nature of these tests and no sample questions are available. The examinations are only conducted at Scotch College on 25 February 2012. An interview and further assessment of short-listed candidates is part of the selection process.

Notification of results

The processing of scholarship results and interviewing of candidates takes some time and, in some cases, the approval of trustees is required before scholarships are awarded. It is anticipated that applicants will be notified of the outcome of the examinations before the end of June. *No details of the performance of candidates will be available.*

Means-tested scholarships

Scholarships are available for boys whose parents would not otherwise be able to afford to send their sons to the school. Parents who apply for these scholarships on the entry form will be sent a form asking for evidence of the need for financial assistance to send their son to the School. Evidence is also required of the boy's record in school work and sport, and of his good character.

Music Scholarships

Scholarships covering instrumental tuition on one or two instruments are offered to boys who show outstanding promise. Total or partial remission of tuition fees may also be included.

The Music Scholarship Auditions will be held on **Sunday, 26 February 2012**, or earlier by arrangement with the Director of Music. Candidates will be notified by the Music School of the audition time during the preceding week. Some auditions may be conducted in the previous week.

Applicants for a Year 7 Scholarship should be of AMEB Grade 6 standard for orchestral instruments, and Grade 7 for pianists. Those applying for a Year 9 or 10 Scholarship should be of AMEB Grade 7 standard for orchestral instruments and Grade 8 for pianists.

Candidates are asked to perform two contrasting works (or contrasting movements from the same work) on their main instrument, and, in the case of students who play more than one instrument, one piece on the second instrument. There will be an aural test (similar to AMEB) and some sight reading. Auditions will last approximately 15 minutes. Candidates must arrange their own accompanist where applicable.
