## Team Reports for the Games of June 25<sup>th</sup>

On Wednesday June 25<sup>th</sup>, the 1sts and the 2nds played against teams from Melbourne Grammar at Scotch College. It was great to see so many supporters from Scotch at the games.

### 1<sup>sts</sup> 46 defeated Melbourne Grammar 25

The 1st team met Melbourne Grammar at Scotch on Wednesday 25 June. A full list with the addition of **Julian Deschepper** was ready to play and took an early lead. This was extended throughout the first half, and Scotch led Melbourne 25 - 8 at the break. **Sandley, Gray, and Deschepper** contributed with 17 of these points and the team applied defensive pressure effectively at the other end. The second half saw a tighter match up and Melbourne scored more easily, but some excellent offensive rebounding from **Cronin** and **Cowan** allowed Scotch to outscore Melbourne 21 - 17 in the second half. Final score Scotch: 46 MGS: 25. **Gray** returned to some shooting form with 12 points, **Deschepper** nailed a couple of big three's and a deuce for 8 pts, and **Sandley, Na Ranong, and Cowan** hit 6 points each. In all, it was a strong performance against a rapidly improving MGS team. Now we enter the play off rounds and if Scotch plays with the same intensity as they did against MGS, we should finish the season in very good shape.
