

Scholarship Terms and Conditions



1. All Scholarships are awarded on the basis of:
 - a. Results of academic or co-curricular aptitude evidenced through relevant reports and academic testing, where appropriate; and
 - b. Supporting documentation provided as part of the application prior to closing date: and
 - c. An audition or other assessment, where required by the Scholarship Panel; and
 - d. An interview, where requested by the Scholarship Panel.
2. To be eligible for a Scholarship at Scotch College, candidates must be an Australian Citizen or a Permanent Resident in Australia (holders of an Australian Permanent Resident Visa).
3. Each application is evaluated on an individual basis. Only shortlisted applicants will be contacted by the School for an interview.
4. All applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of their Scholarship application. The School reserves the right to not provide specific feedback about the outcome of an unsuccessful Scholarship application. All applications are reviewed and considered by the Scholarship Panel and all decisions are final.
5. Scholarship examination results from other schools are not able to be transferred.
6. The value of a Scholarship may be up to the value of 100% of day and/or Boarding fees. However, in most cases, the School will look for families to make some contribution. In some cases, the family's financial capacity is also taken into account (Means Tested Scholarships).
7. Students awarded Scholarships are required to contribute fully to the life of the School, and to maintain high standards in the area of aptitude for which the Scholarship is awarded (Academic Excellence, General Excellence, Boarding etc). The School reserves the right to review a scholar's performance at any time and to withdraw scholarships offered in circumstances where the standards, behaviours or attitudes expected of a scholarship student are not maintained. In addition, the scholarship student is subject to the Enrolment Agreement relevant to all students enrolling at the time. Where a student's scholarship is under question, the School will instigate a process of review using procedures of natural justice.
8. The Scholarship is granted with the expectation that a student will complete Year 12 at Scotch College. Should this not occur, then it is at the discretion of the School to require that the value equivalent to part or all of the Scholarship fee reductions be payable to the School.
9. The number of Scholarships awarded each year will vary at the discretion of the School.
10. The value assigned to each Scholarship awarded in a given year may vary at the discretion of the School.
11. A Scholarship may not be deferred for a later year of entry, except for exceptional circumstances and at the discretion of the Principal.
12. By accepting the Scholarship award, students and parents consent to the usage of the scholarship recipient's name, image and profile to be used for the purposes of marketing and promoting the School's scholarship program. This may include for publication in School newsletters, magazines, website and social media. Such publication might extend beyond the School community and may extend beyond the duration of the scholarship recipient's education at the School. Parents will be informed whenever an image of their child is intended for publication.

13. A Scholarship offer does not cover other costs such as consolidated/sundry charges, uniforms, textbooks, additional music tuition and all optional camps and tours. In exceptional circumstances, or for Means Tested Scholarships where the family's financial capacity is relevant, such costs may be covered in accordance with the request for consideration of means through the submission of a financial assistance form.
14. Scholarship applications will incur a non-refundable Scholarship Application Fee of \$125.
15. Before the end of each school year, each Scholarship recipient will be required to submit a written statement of their contribution to and achievements at the School.
16. Scholarship recipients may be required to write an annual letter of appreciation to the person or family sponsoring their scholarship.
17. These Scholarship Terms and Conditions form part of the contract between the School and the parents or guardians who sign the Enrolment Form, the Enrolment Agreement and the Parent and Community Code of Conduct. These forms are subject to amendment.
