The Junior School will be taking part in the Science Talent Search. The Science Talent Search (STS) is an annual, science-based competition open to all primary and secondary students in Victoria, Australia.

This year's theme is '*Species Survival: More than just sustainability*'.

Students are invited to choose a project from one of the nine categories below and relate it back to the main theme:

Experimental Research
Working Models
Posters – Scientific Wallcharts
Games
Video Productions

Creative Writing
Inventions
Computer Programmes
Science Photography

It is important to note that the STS is optional for all boys and there is no expectation for your son to enter.

Projects that best meet the Science Teachers Association of Victoria (STAV) criteria will be entered in the STAV Science Talent Search Competition. Students will have up until early July to complete their projects.

If your son is interested in participating in this year's Science Talent Search, he will be encouraged to attend a meeting in upcoming weeks to discuss the process and receive further information.
