Election

11. ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD

Pursuant to Rule 18 of the Scotch College Foundation (Inc.) Rules the following information regarding elections must be shared with members:

(1) Nominations

Nominations for election, signed by the Nominee, a proposer and seconder who shall be qualified as Members of the Foundation, shall be forwarded in time to reach the Secretary not less than fourteen days prior to the Annual General Meeting of the Foundation. All elections or appointments to the Board are subject to Rule 10. If:

- there are fewer nominations than vacancies on the Board, then all those who have been nominated shall be deemed to have been elected and the Board may appoint such person(s) to the Board as it thinks fit to fill any vacancy or vacancies, having regard to the requirements of Rule 10;
- the number of nominations is equal to the vacancies on the Board, then those who have been nominated shall be deemed to have been elected; or
- there are more nominations than vacancies on the Board, there shall be an election under Rule 11(3).

If the election or appointment of a candidate to the Board under this Rule 11 would result in the requirements of Rule 10 not being met, the Board may appoint such additional person(s) to the Board as it thinks fit to ensure compliance with the requirements of Rule 10.

(2) Term

Each Board member shall be elected or appointed for a term of three (3) years which will expire at the third Annual General Meeting following their election or appointment.

Notwithstanding Rule 11(2)(a):

- **at the 2024 Annual General Meeting, the terms of one third of the Board members who were elected or appointed at the 2021 Annual General Meeting will be deemed to have expired; and**
- Any Board member whose term is deemed to have expired pursuant to Rules 11(2)(a) or 11(2)(b) will be immediately eligible for re-election and taken to have been nominated for the purposes of Rule 11(1).

Proxies

A member entitled to attend and vote at the Meeting may appoint a person to attend and vote at the meeting as the member's proxy, provided the proxy is a registered member of the Foundation. Proxies may only be appointed by returning the enclosed proxy form to the Secretary at the Scotch College Foundation, 1 Morrison St, Hawthorn, VIC, 3122 no later than 6.30 pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024.
